

HOLY LAND ITINERARY

FEBRUARY 22 - MARCH 3, 2010

MONDAY FEBRUARY 22 USA

Depart for Atlanta from Nashville, Wichita, West Palm Beach, or Miami and connect to our overseas flight to the Holy Land. Dinner and breakfast will be served on board.

TUESDAY FEBRUARY 23 TEL AVIV

Upon arrival at Ben Gurion International airport, we will be met and assisted by a Foundations of Faith representative, then transfer to our hotel on the shores of the Mediterranean Sea for dinner and overnight.



SUNRISE ON THE SEA OF GALILEE

WEDNESDAY FEBRUARY 24 TIBERIAS

We start our sightseeing by driving along the Mediterranean coast to Caesarea, visiting the Roman theater, the aqueduct and Herodian Port. It was in Caesarea that Cornelius became the first Gentile to convert to Christianity (Acts 10). We now drive to Haifa for an overview of Haifa Bay and the Bahai Gardens from the top of Mt. Carmel. Visit Muhraka where Elijah faced off against the prophets of Baal and God sent down fire from Heaven. (I Kings 18:17-46). Continue on to explore Megiddo (I Kings 9:15, Rev. 16:16) in the Biblical Valley of Armageddon and visit Solomon's Stables, the Silo, and the famous Water Tunnel. We then cross the Galilee to Nazareth (Luke 1:26), the boyhood town of Jesus, to visit the Church of Annunciation and Mary's well with a stop at the Wedding Church in the village of Cana (John 2:1-11) where Jesus changed water to wine. Dinner and overnight in Tiberias.

THURSDAY FEBRUARY 25 TIBERIAS

Begin our day with a cruise on the Sea of Galilee. Listen to Jesus' most inspiring words, the Sermon on the Mount, while standing on the Mount of Beatitudes (Matt. 5:1-12)

overlooking the Sea of Galilee; proceeding to Tabgha (Mark 6:30-46), the place of the multiplication of loaves and fishes. At the village of Capernaum (Matt. 4:13, Mark 3:1, 8:5 and 14) we'll visit the ruins of St. Peter's House where Jesus stayed while he was preaching in the local synagogue. We'll continue to Bethsaida and see the town of Phillip, Andrew and Peter (Matt. 11:20-24, Mark 6:45, Luke 10:13-15). The day will conclude with a visit to the Jordan River Baptismal site. Dinner and overnight in Tiberias.

FRIDAY FEBRUARY 26 TIBERIAS

This morning we will drive up into The Golan Heights overlooking the western shores of the Sea of Galilee, site of the Miracle of the Gadarene Swine (Matthew 8:28-34, Mark 5:1-13) marked by the remains of a beautiful 5th century Byzantine church monastery. We'll return to Tiberias stopping off to view the ruins of Korazin, one of the "Jewish Triangle" cities in the time of Jesus (Matthew 11:21). Dinner and overnight in Tiberias.



OVERLOOKING JERUSALEM FROM THE MOUNT OF OLIVES

SATURDAY FEBRUARY 27 JERUSALEM

Drive to Beth Shan to walk through the archaeological site of one of the Roman decapolis cities where King Saul's body was fastened to the city wall (1 Sam 31:10). We will continue down through the Jordan Valley passing Jericho and ascend the hills around Jerusalem (Psalm 121) and proceed to enter the city as pilgrims. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

SUNDAY FEBRUARY 28 JERUSALEM

Today will be spent visiting the Kidron Valley and the tombs of Absalom, Zechariah, and James before beginning our walking tour of the Old City. We will visit St. Stephen's Gate, the Pool of Bethesda (John 5:1-24), the Chapel of the Flagellation, the Ecce Homo Arch and the Antonia Fortress (Matt. 27:11). Visit the Dome of the Rock, the Temple area on Mount Moriah (Gen. 22:2) and see the Golden Gate and Pinnacle. Visit the Western Wall (the Wailing Wall), the Rabbi's Tunnel, and the recently excavated

archaeological sites in the Jewish Quarter. From there we'll continue through the Bazaar to the last stations of the Via Dolorosa. On Mount Zion (John 18:15-27) we'll walk through the Room of the Last Supper, King David's Tomb and the House of the High Priest Caiaphas (Matt. 26:26-35). Leave the gates of the Old City, and visit the Chapel of the Ascension and Church of All Nations. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.



THE RUINS OF MASADA

MONDAY MARCH 1 MASADA / JERUSALEM

Begin our day by viewing the City of Peace from the Mt. of Olives (Acts 1:16). Descend from Jerusalem to where the Jordan River empties into the Dead Sea, arriving at Qumran where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found. After that, we'll ascend the mountain fortress of Masada. It is here that the Jewish Zealots chose to die rather than convert to Roman paganism. Time has even been set aside for floating in the mineral rich Dead Sea before returning to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.

TUESDAY MARCH 2 JERUSALEM

Today we drive to nearby Bethlehem (Matt. 1:18-25, Luke 2:1-7). Visit the Church of the Nativity, Manger Square and the Shepherd's Fields. Return to Jerusalem, visit Yad Vashem, the Memorial to the Holocaust. Proceed via the Hebrew University and the Knesset to the Israel Museum where the Dead Sea Scroll collection is exhibited and see the Model of Jerusalem from Jesus' time. The final stop on our pilgrimage will be a visit to the Garden Tomb of Jesus where we will share a communion service. We will have a farewell dinner before transferring to the airport to check in for our departure flight.

WEDNESDAY MARCH 3 USA

Return flight to USA. Arrive home with inspired memories and new friends.
